THE COURT DIRECTS THAT:

1. Pursuant to s 596F(1)(f) of the *Corporations Act 2001*, until the conclusion of all of the examinations the subject of summonses issued in relation to the liquidation of Mosaic Brands Limited (In Liquidation) (Receivers and Managers Appointed) (ACN 003 321 597) and the related entities the subject of this proceeding, each examinee not communicate to any other examinee about the questions asked, or the answers given, at his or her examination.

THE COURT ORDERS THAT:

Bill Zuo

2. Pursuant to s 597(17) of the Corporations Act:
 - a. the examination of Bill Zuo be adjourned generally;
 - b. leave be granted to the Plaintiffs to apply for a time and date to be fixed for the resumption of the examination; and
 - c. if no application is made (or is made and refused) within the period of 6 months beginning today, the examination be taken to have concluded on the last day of that period.



3. Pursuant to s 597(13) of the Corporations Act:
 - a. the questions put to, and answers given by, Mr Zuo be recorded in writing; and
 - b. Mr Zuo sign a copy of that written record within 14 days of receiving notice in writing from the Plaintiffs that the written record is ready to be signed.
4. To avoid doubt, pursuant to r 11.7(b) of the *Federal Court (Corporations) Rules 2000*, Mr Zuo authenticate a copy of a transcript of his examination by signing his name at the bottom of each page of the written record of the examination insofar as records a part of the examination at which he was present, within 14 days of receiving notice in writing from the Plaintiffs that the written record is ready to be signed.

5. Pursuant to s 597(17) of the Corporations Act:
 - a. the examination of Andy Lam be adjourned generally;
 - b. leave be granted to the Plaintiffs to apply for a time and date to be fixed for the resumption of the examination; and
 - c. if no application is made (or is made and refused) within the period of 6 months beginning today, the examination be taken to have concluded on the last day of that period.
6. Pursuant to s 597(13) of the Corporations Act:
 - a. the questions put to, and answers given by, Mr Lam be recorded in writing; and
 - b. Mr Lam sign a copy of that written record within 14 days of receiving notice in writing from the Plaintiffs that the written record is ready to be signed.
7. To avoid doubt, pursuant to r 11.7(b) of the Corporations Rules, Mr Lam authenticate a copy of a transcript of his examination by signing his name at the bottom of each page of the written record of the examination insofar as records a part of the examination at which he was present, within 14 days of receiving notice in writing from the Plaintiffs that the written record is ready to be signed.

Erica Berchtold

8. Pursuant to s 597(17) of the Corporations Act:



- a. the examination of Erica Berchtold be adjourned generally;
- b. leave be granted to the Plaintiffs to apply for a time and date to be fixed for the resumption of the examination; and
- c. if no application is made (or is made and refused) within the period of 6 months beginning today, the examination be taken to have concluded on the last day of that period.

9. Pursuant to s 597(13) of the Corporations Act:

- a. the questions put to, and answers given by, Ms Berchtold be recorded in writing; and
- b. Ms Berchtold sign a copy of that written record within 14 days of receiving notice in writing from the Plaintiffs that the written record is ready to be signed.

10. To avoid doubt, pursuant to r 11.7(b) of the Corporations Rules, Ms Berchtold authenticate a copy of a transcript of her examination by signing her name at the bottom of each page of the written record of the examination insofar as records a part of the examination at which she was present, within 14 days of receiving notice in writing from the Plaintiffs that the written record is ready to be signed.
